Students must understand that driving an automobile to WCHS and Parking on school property is a privilege and not a right. Parking privileges may be suspended or permanently revoked for the following reasons:

- 1) Failure to maintain a 2.0 G.P.A.
- 2) Being in the parking area during the school day without permission.
- 3) Transferring or receiving a parking tag that belongs to another vehicle.
- 4) Parking in unauthorized areas.
- 5) Exceeding the 5 mph speed limit in the parking area.
- 6) Reckless driving and/or speeding in the parking lot or within the perimeter of the school grounds at anytime. (Wells Road, Curley Road, and Boyette Road included)
- 7) Excessive absences and/or tardies to school.
- 8) Leaving Campus without permission and/or transporting students off campus without permission.

WCHS and the District School Board of Pasco County are not responsible for any theft, damage, vandalism, or mishap that may occur to any vehicle on the campus of WCHS.

Parking Procedures

Parking at Wesley Chapel High School is a privilege. When a student wants to park on campus during the school day, their vehicle must be properly registered. Please review all Parking Procedures with your parent/guardian.

Guidelines

- 1) Limited parking spaces are provided for students in the parking area. Student parking is in a designated area only; there is no parking on the grass, in the fire lanes, faculty/staff parking areas, or in visitor parking areas.
- 2) Juniors and Seniors who qualify (see below) may purchase parking tags. The remaining tags will be sold through a lottery to qualified students.
- 3) Loitering in the parking area is not permitted. After entering the parking area, all students must leave their cars immediately, report to class, and remain on campus the entire school day. If a student leaves campus without signing out through Student Services, his/her parking will be revoked.
- 4) Cars are not to be used as lockers; students should return to their cars only when leaving at the end of the day or after signing out in Student Services.
- 5) Students who have been approved to work during the school day may leave at the appropriate time and park only in the designated area.

Qualifications

To qualify for a parking tag a student must:

- 1) Have a valid operator driver's license.
- 2) Pay a \$15.00 fee.
- 3) Be cleared of all school obligations from the previous school year(s).
- 4) Have a 2.0 cumulative GPA.

Parking Tag Regulations

- 1) Once issued, the parking tag cannot be altered. Tags must be permanently and visibly displayed on the front windshield.
- 2) A parking tag may not be removed for any reason other than to turn it in. Consequence: The parking tag will be revoked.
- 3) A lost tag will be replaced for a fee of \$3.00.

Suspension/Revocation

A student's parking privilege may be suspended or permanently revoked for the following reasons:

- 1) Failure to maintain a 2.0 GPA.
- 2) Being in a parking area during the school day without permission.
- 3) Transferring or receiving a parking tag that belongs to another vehicle.
- 4) Parking in unauthorized areas.
- 5) Exceeding the 5 mph speed limit in parking areas.
- 6) Reckless driving and/or speeding in the parking lot, or within the perimeter of the school grounds: Wells Road, Curley Road, and Boyette Road included.
- 7) Excessive absences and/or tardies to school.
- 8) Leaving campus without permission.

Miscellaneous

- 1) If a student's parking privilege has been revoked or denied, under no circumstances will that student be granted a temporary parking permit.
- 2) Vehicles displaying words, graphics, or designs that are in poor taste or create a disruption in the opinion of Wesley Chapel High School Administration are prohibited.
- 3) To ensure the safety and protection of the student population, Florida Law provides for a search of any vehicle on campus by the Administration upon reasonable suspicion that a violation of the Code of Conduct is occurring at the school or at a school function.
- 4) Students who continue to park their vehicle at school without permission or authorization are subject to having their vehicle towed at their own expense.
- 5) The Administration of Wesley Chapel High School reserves the right to make any adjustments they deem necessary to enforce student-parking regulations.
