# WHAT IS THE AP CAPSTONE DIPLOMA?

- ► AP Capstone™ is a College Board program that equips students with the independent research, collaborative teamwork, and communication skills that are increasingly valued by colleges.
- AP Capstone Diploma is a nationally recognized advanced diploma offered by the College Board. (The same company that does PSAT, SAT, and AP)
- It requires:
  - 4 AP courses with passing AP exam scores (score of 3 is passing)
  - AP Seminar course in 11th grade
  - AP Research course in 12th grade



# WHAT MAKES AP SPECIAL?

- Students can take the elective courses of their choice
- Students take Advance Placement coursework that exposes them to college-level rigor and have the opportunity to earn college credit with a passing score on the AP Test
  - AP History
  - AP Science
  - AP English
  - AP Math
  - AP Language
  - AP Music





- Participating in AP Capstone can help students:
  - Stand out to colleges in the application process
  - Develop key academic skills they'll use in college and beyond
  - Become self-confident, independent thinkers and problem solvers
  - Earn college credit

### WHO IS THERE TO HELP?

#### **TEACHER REQUIREMENTS FOR TEACHING AP CAPSTONE**

Professional development is required for both AP Seminar and AP Research teachers. The summer before the first year of teaching the course, teachers must complete a five-day workshop. During the winter of each year of teaching the course, teachers must complete around 10 hours of additional online training.
