EXPECTATIONS

STUDENTS WHO BRING ELECTRONIC DEVICES TO SCHOOL MUST ENSURE THAT THEY REMAIN ON SILENT MODE AND COMPLETELY OUT OF VIEW FOR THE ENTIRE SCHOOL DAY.

IF A STUDENT NEEDS TO USE THEIR PHONE, THEY MUST GET ADMINISTRATIVE APPROVAL.

THE USE OF ELECTRONIC DEVICES THAT CONTAIN BUILT-IN CAMERAS] I.E. DEVICES THAT TAKE STILL OR MOTION PICTURES, WHETHER IN A DIGITAL OR OTHER FORMAT] IS PROHIBITED IN LOCKER ROOMS, SHOWER FACILITIES, AND RESTROOMS.

IN CLASSROOMS, STUDENTS MUST STORE THEIR DEVICE IN THE TEACHER DESIGNATED LOCATION.

STUDENTS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO TAKE THEIR ELECTRONIC DEVICE WITH THEM LEAVING THE CLASSROOM DURING INSTRUCTIONAL TIME FOR BATHROOM BREAKS.
